Triple 'R' Driving School is designed to offer an affordable and professional driver education option for students in Marion and Jasper County. Students must be at least 14 years of age and **MUST** possess a **valid instructional driving permit** prior to registration. Other pertinent information is as follows:

- The spring classroom session will begin on Monday, March 6th. At this time online modules will become available; modules will have designated time frames in which to complete the assigned material. Students will work independently on the assigned curriculum and will have through the month of March to complete all modules and assignments. Classroom modules will meet or exceed 30 hours of driver education curriculum. **There will be an arranged Zoom session to go over details for the class on Sunday, March 5th at 8pm. The Zoom link and other details will be emailed to students and families approximately 3-5 days before the first day of class.**
- The State of Iowa MANDATES six hours of behind the wheel instruction and 30 hours of classroom instruction.
- **A driving schedule will be arranged by the instructors based on student and instructor availability.**
- The cost of the course will be \$305.00. A \$150.00 deposit is required with registration (no deposit is required for those eligible for free tuition; a \$140 fee is required for those on reduced lunch). Deposits are refundable if notification is given prior to the start of driver education. Refunds of any kind **will not be issued** once driver education has initiated. The balance of tuition will be collected on the first day of class (**please plan accordingly**). Please make checks payable to **Triple R Driving School L.L.C.** Certificates of completion will not be issued until all financial obligations have been fulfilled.
- **Knoxville students who are subject to a free or reduced rate should indicate that on the registration form they return for enrollment (write "Free" or "Reduced" on form; those qualifying for reduced lunch should include a \$140 payment).**
- Knoxville students enrolling can mail registration forms to the above address OR drop off registration form and deposit to Stacy or Natasha in the Knoxville High School office.
- All driving will originate and finish from Knoxville High School.
- Mr. Tom Grimm and Ms. Paige Bolton will be the classroom and in-car instructors for this session.

Operating Agreement for Triple 'R' Driving School

It is the intent of the Triple R Driving School and affiliates of the company to provide instruction and experience to students of all ages in driver education. Instructors of Triple R Driving School are certified teachers in the state of Iowa. The format of the school may vary depending on the time of year (spring, summer, fall, etc.), although instructional content will remain the same.

Iowa State requirements will be met or exceeded:

1. Length of the day in the classroom may not exceed 180 minutes.
2. Number of classroom hours will be a minimum of 30 hours.
3. Students will receive 240 minutes of substance abuse education.
4. Students will receive a minimum of 20 minutes of railroad crossing safety.
5. Students will be provided instruction relating to the organ donation under the Uniform Anatomical Gift Act.
6. Two or more students **will be scheduled** for all behind-the-wheel instruction.
7. 30 minutes per session, 60 minutes per day is the maximum a student may drive in one day.
8. The minimum number of times a student will drive in a dual control automobile during the entire course without simulation or range is 12.
9. A maximum of 360 minutes of range instruction may be substituted for behind-the-wheel instruction.
10. All driver education instructors, with the exception of behind-the-wheel instructors, must hold a valid Iowa secondary teaching license and the Driver Education endorsement.

In the unfortunate event of an accident/collision with a student behind the wheel, Triple 'R' will ask that the student or family of the student cover half of the deductible for collision repairs (\$500.00 deductible for collision insurance; \$250.00 responsibility to student or student's family).

It is our intent that all students will complete the course at program's end. However, students with excessive absences, tardies, deficient driving abilities or disruptive behavior (as judged by the instructor) will be dismissed from the program or be required to obtain more driving experience before being issued a certificate of completion. Additional driving experience may be obtained with the instructor or other persons meeting state requirements as at the discretion of the instructor. Additional driving with the instructor will be \$40.00 per hour.

Upon completion of the course, students will be awarded a certificate of completion. The certificate will allow them eligibility for an intermediate driver's license under the Graduated License System of the state of Iowa, and also allow them eligibility for a school permit (if eligibility criteria are met). All other Graduated License requirements must be met (see graduated license information from the Department of Transportation). Lost certificates of completion can be duplicated with a \$40.00 fee.

Any student not showing up for their scheduled drive during the course of drivers education will be subject to a \$40.00 fee.
